

SE4EO – COMMITMENT TO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Provide graphed data (displayed as a percentage) of baseline data, plus two years of data, demonstrating nursing has met or exceeded a targeted goal at the organizational level, for improvement in professional board certification.

In the beginning of 2022, NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia University Irving Medical Center (NYP/Columbia) developed strategic initiatives to increase the organizational level professional nursing board certification rate by one percentage point over the next two years from 41 percent (baseline in 2021) to 42 percent by 2023. The graph below represents NYP/Columbia meeting the targeted goal for improvement in professional nursing board certification rate.
