

SE6EO – COMMITMENT TO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Provide graphed data (displayed as a percentage) of baseline data, plus two years of data, demonstrating nursing has met or exceeded a targeted goal at the unit or division level, for improvement in professional board certification.

At NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia University Irving Medical Center (NYP/Columbia), the Psychiatric (9GN-605501) Unit developed a goal in 2022 to increase the percentage of board-certified registered nurses at the unit level by one percentage point over two years, from 40 percent (baseline in 2021) to 41 percent in 2023. The graph below represents 9GN exceeding the targeted goal for improvement in professional nursing board certification.
