### CARE COORDINATION OF A KIDNEY AND BONE MARROW TRANSPLANT PATIENT

*Provide one example, with supporting evidence, of nurse's(s') participation in interprofessional collaborative practice to ensure coordination of care from an ambulatory care setting to an inpatient setting.*

#### **PANORAMA Study**

NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia University Irving Medical Center (NYP/Columbia) supports cutting-edge research protocols to advance patient care. The Institutional Review Board-approved study, PANORAMA, began in 2023 and was conducted by physicians to determine the optimal regimen for renal allograft tolerance – the proportion of recipients off immunosuppression with maintenance of good renal function at month 24 post-transplant – while minimizing chimeric transition syndrome (CTS). During this study, nurses participated in interprofessional collaboration to ensure coordination of care of study participants who underwent intense conditioning treatments in the Infusion Center (606544) [Infusion Center] (ambulatory setting) on the fourteenth floor of the Herbert Irving Pavilion (HIP14) and then were admitted as an inpatient to the BMT (HP11-605182) [BMT HP11] Unit for a kidney and bone marrow transplant.

#### **Care Coordination from Ambulatory Setting to Inpatient BMT Unit**

Nurse Coordinators play a critical role in coordinating care for patients who are eligible to participate in the PANORAMA study. The pre-hospital care, conducted in the ambulatory setting required an intense conditioning regimen. This regimen needed to be completed as a series of outpatient appointments at NYP/Columbia, after which the patient would be directly admitted to the hospital as an inpatient for transplant surgery.

On January 9, 2023, Thresiamma (Theresa) Lukose, PharmD, Director of Clinical Research Operations, emailed Maria Fenton, MPA, BSN, RN, Bone Marrow Transplant

Coordinator, and Kate Blair, BSN, RN, OCN, Inpatient Oncology Coordinator, to collaborate on the care for a 65-year-old patient (X.X.) enrolled in the PANORAMA study as a direct admission from his home to BMT HP11. Ms. Fenton responded that she would communicate in the electronic medical record regarding X.X.'s expected direct admission under the care of Markus Mapara, MD, NYP/Columbia Director of the Blood and Marrow Transplantation/Cell Therapy Program. Ms. Blair communicated to the ambulatory team that pre-admission care orders were needed prior to admission including testing for coronavirus-19 (COVID-19) up to 72 hours prior to the admission. Ms. Lukose acknowledged the request and coordinated services to ensure the testing was completed during the patient's ambulatory appointment on January 17, 2023.

On January 12, 2023, Ms. Fenton scheduled a virtual video appointment for X.X. on January 13, 2023, with Adrienne Mishkin, MD, MPH, psychiatric liaison to the BMT Program at NYP/Columbia, in preparation for his conditioning regimen that was scheduled to begin on January 17, 2023. Ms. Fenton emailed the team to ensure that X.X. would be made aware of the appointment and provided hand-off communication and contact information for any follow-up needs. On January 17, 2023, Ms. Fenton emailed the protocol and patient-specific plan for X.X. to nurses and the interprofessional team, including physicians, the physician's assistant, laboratory, and pharmacy personnel. The patient was scheduled to receive non-myeloablative chemotherapy on the Infusion Center (ambulatory setting) and then be admitted to BMT HP11 for bone marrow and kidney transplant surgery on January 26, 2023. In the plan, Ms. Fenton communicated the upcoming six-day treatment program as an outpatient leading up to the inpatient admission and transplant date. Her communication of the detailed plan prompted ambulatory nurses, including Deanna Carlisi, BSN, RN, BMTCN, to ask pertinent questions of the team and time for Ms. Fenton to answer the question so all healthcare team members understood the plan and sequence of events. X.X. was scheduled for inpatient dialysis on January 20, 2023, coming in from home that morning to be admitted as an inpatient on BMT HP11. Ms. Fenton emailed the BMT team on January 19, 2023, to coordinate admission to a BMT room for X.X. and reminded the team of the complexity of the patient's plan of care. In order to arrange this transition, Ms. Fenton communicated with a number of interprofessional colleagues to coordinate the plan, including Angela Sanchez, Research Coordinator, and Chrissa Pantazis, MSPAS, PA-C, physician assistant, Blood and Marrow Transplant/Multiple Myeloma Service, Division of Hematology/Oncology. As a result of Ms. Fenton and Ms. Blair's coordination efforts, X.X. had a smooth transition from the outpatient setting receiving intense conditioning on the Infusion Center to his inpatient admission on BMT HP11 for a kidney and bone marrow transplant.
