

## EP11 – STAFFING, SCHEDULING, AND BUDGETING PROCESSES

*Provide one example, with supporting evidence, when nurse(s) collaborated with a nurse AVP/Nurse Director and/or Nurse Manager during budgeting to acquire new or redistribute existing resources.*

### **Investigating Hemodialysis Employee Injuries**

During the Dialysis Unit (PH4-605721) [Dialysis] at NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia University Irving Medical Center (NYP/Columbia) daily huddle in March 2020, clinical nurses Lisa Su Cabatu, BSN, RN, CNN; Goldie Tan, BSN, RN, CNN; and Mario Fetiza, CCHT, dialysis technician, reported on the increased injuries involving both nurses and technicians during transport of hemodialysis equipment to Jane Akomeah, MSN, RN, FNP-BC, Patient Care Director (nurse manager, at the time), and Robin Ferrer, MBA, MSN, RN, Director of Nursing (at the time). Hemodialysis nurses and technicians often transport two pieces of equipment when performing hemodialysis at the patient bedside: the hemodialysis machine and a portable reverse osmosis (RO) machine.

Ms. Cabatu, Ms. Tan, and Mr. Fetiza raised the recurring issue of the machine wheels falling into the gap between the elevator and floor specifically on the first floor of NYP/Columbia's Milstein Hospital Building where one of two Dialysis Units is located. The employees needed to manually lift the machine wheels out of the gaps while pushing forward, creating musculoskeletal injuries and leading to employee absences. Following the staff meeting, Ms. Akomeah requested John Duffy, MS, CHT, Biomedical Manager (at the time), and the biomed team to assess the wheels on the hemodialysis and RO machines. The biomed team determined that the wheels were intact and functioning properly as intended by the manufacturer. They found that the equipment wheels fall into the gap if the wheels were not forward-facing during transport.

Ms. Akomeah then reached out to Emmanuel DeSoto, Facilities Manager, NYP/Columbia, to assess the status of the elevators. Mr. DeSoto and the elevator company representative confirmed the gap was a necessary elevator feature to enable the elevators to travel between floors. The elevators were found to be functioning properly and the gaps were noted to be within the industry standard.

## **Clinical Nurse Input on Hemodialysis Equipment Resources**

After verifying that the issue was neither caused by faulty wheels nor defective elevators, Ms. Akomeah collaborated with the Dialysis Unit Council clinical nurses and technicians to identify a solution. The unit council was committed to preventing work-related injuries and determined this to be a financial priority since the COVID-19 pandemic was starting to put a strain on staffing resources.

At a daily huddle in early April 2020, Ms. Akomeah presented to Mr. Ferrer and Mr. Duffy, unit council members, as well as other staff who were present, an alternative option of motorized carts to safely transport hemodialysis equipment. The motorized carts were designed to bolster transport safety, optimize bedside dialysis workflow, and allow for transport of both hemodialysis and RO machines as a single unit with a push of a button. Additionally, the carts were configured to fit the current fleet of hemodialysis and RO machines. The clinical nurses came to a consensus in favor of exploring the motorized cart.

Mr. Duffy contacted PHS West Inc., a dialysis vendor, to obtain more information on the cart and schedule a demonstration. In mid-April 2020, PHS West Inc. performed a virtual demonstration with Ms. Akomeah, Mr. Duffy, hemodialysis clinical nurses and technicians, and the biomedical team. They presented two motorized cart models with varying price points during the demonstration. One cart provided the ability for the hemodialysis and RO machines to be separated (retractable) once the equipment reached the patient's bedside. The other model was a one-piece model that did not allow for detachment of the machines. [EP11.1—Email scheduling virtual demo with RNs](#)

The hemodialysis nurses evaluated the features, functionality, and cost of each model with Ms. Akomeah. They agreed to move forward with the model that allowed the machines to be detached (retractable) to maximize the limited space available inside patient rooms.

## **Nurse Manager Collaboration with Nurse Director During Budgeting**

On April 17, 2020, Ms. Akomeah presented a quote to Mr. Ferrer for two retractable motorized carts and two hitches. [EP11.2—Motorized Cart Quote](#)

On April 20, 2020, during a 1:1 discussion about budgeting for the motorized carts with Mr. Ferrer, Ms. Akomeah finalized the recommended number of carts (three or four) to purchase for bedside and on-call cases. To mitigate installation costs, the biomed team planned to attach the hitches to select hemodialysis machines. [EP11.3—Discussion with Mr. Ferrer Notes](#)

## **Acquisition of a New Resource**

The HD Unit acquired three retractable motorized carts. One of the three carts and hitches arrived for the HD Unit in May 2020. The first cart was assembled, installed, and tested, and the hitches were attached by the biomedical team in June 2020. Due to supply chain issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the other carts were significantly delayed. The remaining two carts were received, inspected, and deployed to the HD Unit in June 2021 and October 2021. [EP11.4—Motorized Cart Inspection and Installation Work Orders](#)

On July 6, 2021, Ms. Akomeah communicated via email to her team about the upcoming training for the acquired motorized carts. On July 8, 2020, PHS West Inc. conducted an on-site in-service for the hemodialysis nurses and technicians. As a safety precaution and due to limited vendor access into the hospital related to the COVID-19 pandemic, Ms. Akomeah and the hemodialysis nurses employed a train-the-trainer model. Those initially trained assisted in training the remaining hemodialysis nurses and technicians, who all began using the new and safer carts. [EP11.5—Vendor In-Service Email](#)

The nurses' communication and collaboration during the budgeting process allowed for the acquisition of new motorized carts, which improved safety for hemodialysis nurses and technicians.

#### **NEW COVID-19 Quarantine Guidelines:**

To clinical managers and all health care providers:

Within the last week, several new recommendations and regulations related to the prevention of COVID-19 transmission have been released by New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (NYCDOHMH) and New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH). These are due to the changing epidemiology of the COVID-19 pandemic as transmission in our region has remained low while transmission in other regions of the country has been rising. NYCDOHMH, NYSDOH and NYP/Columbia/Weill Cornell guidance have changed to reflect this

changing epidemiology. We expect that as the epidemiology of the pandemic continues to evolve, public health recommendations and our guidance will continue to change. As always, please see the NYP Infonet [COVID-19 website](#) for the most updated guidance. We appreciate everyone's attention to these evolving guidelines.

## **SUMMARY OF KEY CHANGES:**

### **Expansion of PPE to include universal eye protection for all direct patient care**

*Rationale: PCR tests for the SARS-CoV-2 virus can have false negative results due to inadequate specimen collection. Furthermore, patients can be early in their incubation period and become positive many days after initially testing negative. Additionally, PCR testing is not generally performed or recommended prior to routine ambulatory care visits. While universal masking should prevent most exposures, there are patients who may not be able to wear masks reliably and occasions during a clinical encounter when some patients will need to remove their mask. Furthermore, additional protection may be needed for aerosol-generating procedures.*

- **Universal Eye Protection, in addition to universal mask use, is recommended for ALL healthcare personnel (HCP) providing direct patient care in all healthcare settings, regardless of whether the patient is wearing a face covering or face mask.**
- **N95 respirators are now recommended for ALL aerosol-generating procedures, regardless of whether the patient has suspected or confirmed COVID-19 or a positive or negative SARS-CoV-2 PCR test.**

### **Furlough/quarantine of HCP with high-risk exposures to COVID-19 in the community or health care setting**

*Rationale: New York City is beyond the initial peak of the COVID-19 pandemic. To maintain suppression of the pandemic, NYS and NYC are expanding contact tracing efforts and implementing quarantine of people who have been exposed to COVID-19.*

- Based on NYCDOHMH, effective Thursday, July 2, 2020, **NYP will furlough for 14 days those HCP who had confirmed high-risk, unprotected exposures to COVID-19 in the community or healthcare setting.** These HCP should remain quarantined in their homes for 14 days and not report to work.

### **Exposure and Travel screening of all patients and visitors**

*Rationale: Based on the changing epidemiology of the pandemic and NYSDOH quarantine regulations, patients and visitors should be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 as well as exposure to COVID-19 and travel to states with high transmission rates of COVID-19 that are on the NYSDOH Travel Advisory list.*

- **All patients and visitors should be screened for exposure within the past 14 days to persons with newly diagnosed COVID-19.** Exposed patients should be placed in a single room and offered SARS-CoV-2 PCR testing. Exposed visitors may not visit until 14 days have elapsed from the time of their last exposure.
- **All patients and visitors should be screened for travel to New York from states with significant rates of transmission of COVID-19, as defined by NYSDOH, on or after June 25, 2020.** ([Click here](#) for link to current list of states). Patients with such travel should be placed in a single room and offered SARS-CoV-2 PCR testing. Visitors with such travel, if without symptoms and having no known exposures, are allowed to visit but should be

reminded to wear a mask at all times and not to visit if symptoms develop, and otherwise must adhere to self-quarantine requirements.

- Visitors whose *only* exposure is a hospitalized patient with COVID-19 are permitted because such visitors wear PPE.
- Asymptomatic support persons/visitors for pediatric patients or patients in labor and delivery units are permitted to accompany the patient.

### **HCP with travel to states with significant rates of COVID-19 transmission**

- **All HCP with travel to affected states as above, who returned to New York on or after June 25, 2020, should get tested within 24 hours at a local testing site or arrange for a testing via Workforce Health & Safety Hotline (646-697-9470) upon return.**
- HCP with travel may return to work if they test negative. Upon return to work, HCP must perform temperature checks and monitor for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 and continue to wear all appropriate PPE.
